>Starting Monday, July 23rd, Gulf Power will be trimming the trees under the power line that runs from the three way stop at Baytowne Ave & Baytowne Village Drive (previously Blue Heron Drive) to the tennis center. Please use caution in this area as traffic may be limited to one lane travel during this project, with traffic control personnel in the roadway. This project will continue thru Wednesday. If the work is not complete, Gulf Power will return next Monday to continue. No trees will be removed, just trimmed back about ten feet.
